GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

School begins at 8:00 a.m. daily. On-time attendance is required.

Dismissal: Mon—Thurs. Pre-K & Kinder - 1:30 p.m.
Grades 1- 6 at 2:00 p.m.

Fridays: Pre-K—Grade 6 at 1:00 p.m.

N.B. Students are to be picked up within one and a half hour after dismissal each day. If this is not possible, prior arrangements must be made with the administration for the Aftercare Programme.

Students are to be attired in uniforms which include black shoes, navy blue socks, blue or white hair accessories. **NO JEWELLERY OR EXTENTIONS, BOYS' HAIR SHOULD NOT BE CLEAN SHAVEN.**

No playing in the mornings: Students should be in their classes engaged in meaningful activities

No cellular phones and toys are allowed.

Buying over the fence and eating on the street is prohibited and is punishable.

Students must refrain from loud talking, crude or rough language.

Fighting, quarrelling and rough playing are strictly out of place.

No lunch credits: Lunch money is payable in advance.

Exams are given at the end of the Christmas, Easter and Summer Terms. Reports should be collected as advised.
